Garry Steel - accordion, keyboards.

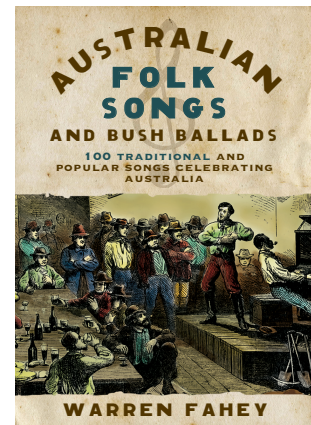
Mark Oats (fiddle) is also available as an 'optional extra'.
